What is Future Hartford?
Future Hartford is a leadership skill development program sponsored by the Hartford Area Chamber of Commerce.

Enrolled candidates, identified as emerging leaders within their company, participate in this program in preparation to serve in a leadership capacity at work and in public and community positions throughout the greater Hartford area.

Each program day begins with a business-related educational session on various aspects of leadership and provides candidates with in-depth exposure to important aspects of the community through a series of discussions and site visits.
